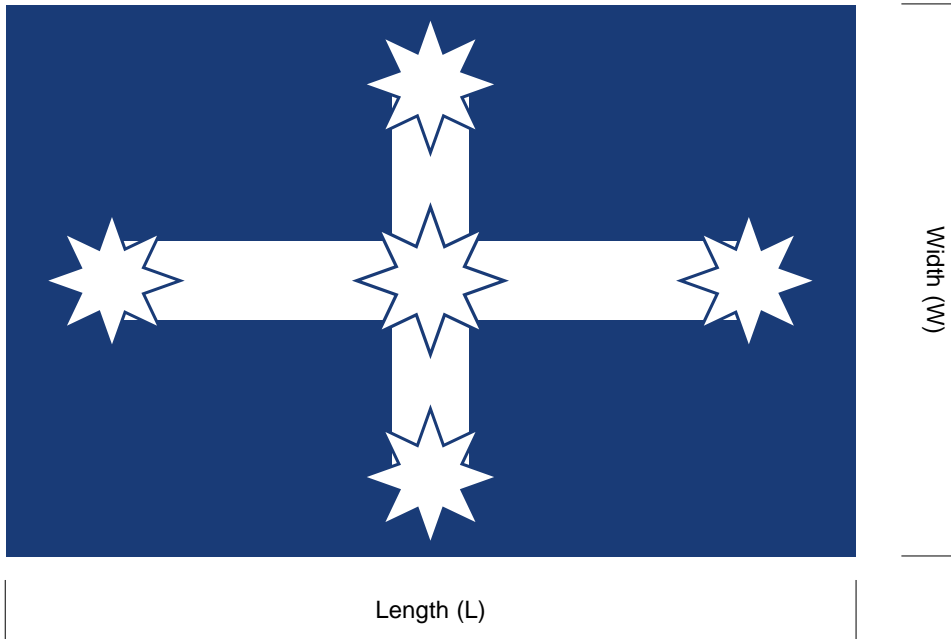


Eureka Flag Description

The Eureka Flag (The Southern Cross Flag) is a blue flag and has:

- (a) the proportion of 13:20 (W:L);
- (b) a white cross in the centre of the flag, each arm of the cross not extending to the edge of the flag, as specified in Table A;
- (c) an eight-pointed star centrally located over the ends of each arm of the cross, as specified in Table B;
- (d) a larger eight-pointed star over the centre of the cross, as specified in Table B; and
- (e) each star has a blue border the same colour as the background, as specified in Table B.

Table A – The Cross *

	Position	Length In fractions of length of flag	Thickness In fractions of length of flag
Horizontal arm	Centred	0.7625	0.0925
Vertical arm	Centred	0.4625	0.09

Table B – The Stars and Borders *

	Position of centre	Outer Diameter In fractions of length of flag	Inner Diameter In fractions of outer diameter
Centre Star	Centre of flag	0.1625	Half
Centre Star Border	Centre of flag	0.185	Half
Outer 4 Stars	Centred over the ends of each arm	0.15	Half
Outer Stars' Borders	Centred over the ends of each arm	0.17125	Half
